 JUDGE SEATS TO PROVIDE FOR SINGLE MEMBER DISTRICTS AND EQUAL
 REPRESENTATION IN THOSE DISTRICTS, WHICH ARE TO BE DETERMINED.
- 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
 - **SECTION 1.** G.S. 7A-41(a) reads as rewritten:

7 "(a) The counties of the State are organized into judicial divisions and superior court 8 districts, and each superior court district has the counties, and the number of regular resident 9 superior court judges set forth in the following table, and for districts of less than a whole 10 county, as set out in subsection (b) of this section:
