A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO CHANGE THE QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENT FOR A COUNTY SERVICE DISTRICT ESTABLISHED FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. G.S. 153A-301(a)(10) reads as rewritten: "(a) The board of commissioners of any county may define any number of service districts in order to finance, provide, or maintain for the districts one or more of the following services, facilities and functions in addition to or to a greater extent than those financed, provided or maintained for the entire county:		
(10)	 Law enforcement if all of the following apply: a. The population of the county is (i) over 500,000 to the most recent federal decennial eensus, censure ten percent (10%) of the population of the unincorporated area according to the most recensus. b. The county has an interlocal agreement or agreemunicipality or municipalities for the provision under which the city provides law enforcement so unincorporated area of the county. 	ements with a city n of in the county
