| 17       | (8b) The Board of Governors shall adopt a policy that prohibits any constituent                                 |
| 18       | institution from soliciting or using information regarding the accreditation of                                 |
| 19       | a secondary school that a person attended as a factor affecting admissions,                                     |
| 20       | loans, scholarships, or other educational activity at the constituent   |
| 21       | institution, unless the accreditation was conducted by a State agency. For                                      |
| 22       | purposes of this subdivision, the term 'accreditation' shall include  |
| 23       | certification or any other similar approval process."   |
| 24       | <b>SECTION 2.</b> Article 1 of Chapter 115D of the General Statutes is amended by                               |
| 25       | adding a new section to read:   |
| 26       | " <u>§ 115D-1.3. Accreditation of secondary school shall not be a factor in admissions, loans,</u>              |
| 27       | scholarships, or other educational policies.  |
| 28       | (a) For purposes of this section, the term 'accreditation' shall include certification or any                   |
| 29       | other similar approval process.   |
| 30       | (b) The State Board of Community Colleges shall adopt a policy that prohibits any                               |
| 31       | community college from soliciting or using information regarding the accreditation of a                         |
| 32       | secondary school that a person attended as a factor affecting admissions, loans, scholarships, or               |

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| 1  | "§ 115C-12. Powers and duties of the Board generally.   |
| 2  | The general supervision and administration of the free public school system shall be vested   |
| 3  | in the State Board of Education. The State Board of Education shall establish policy for the  |
| 4  | system of free public schools, subject to laws enacted by the General Assembly. The powers    |
| 5  | and duties of the State Board of Education are defined as follows:                            |
| 6  |   |
| 7  | (38) Power to accredit schools. – Upon the request of a local board of education,             |
| 8  | the State Board of Education shall evaluate schools in local school                           |
| 9  | administrative units to determine whether the education provided by those                     |
| 10 | schools meets acceptable levels of quality. The State Board shall adopt                       |
| 11 | rigorous academic standards for accreditation after consideration of (i) the                  |
| 12 | standards of regional and national accrediting agencies, (ii) the Common                      |
| 13 | Core Standards adopted by the National Governors Association Center for                       |
| 14 | Best Practices and the Council of Chief State School Officers, and (iii) other                |
| 15 | information it deems appropriate.   |
| 16 | The local school administrative unit shall compensate the State Board for                     |
| 17 | the actual costs of the accreditation process."   |
| 18 | <b>SECTION 4.</b> The receipts collected by the State Board of Education pursuant to          |
| 19 | G.S. 115C-12(38), as enacted by Section 3 of this act, are hereby appropriated to the         |
| 20 | Department of Public Instruction for the 2010-2011 fiscal year and the 2011-2012 fiscal year. |
| 21 | These funds are in addition to other funds appropriated to the Department for the 2010-2011   |
| 22 | fiscal year and the 2011-2012 fiscal year.  |
| 23 | <b>SECTION 5.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law. Sections 1 and 2 of this act     |
| 24 | apply to academic semesters beginning on or after July 1, 2011.                               |
