- (a) By January 1, 2013, the Director shall develop and make publicly available a single, searchable budget database Web site including the required data for the 2011-2013 fiscal biennium. The Web site shall be given a unique and simplified Web site address. In addition to the information specified by G.S. 147-33.122 that shall be made accessible through the single, searchable budget database Web site, the Web site shall also provide, where possible, a hyperlink to the actual grants or contracts that is a funding action or expenditure.
- (b) Each State agency that maintains a generally accessible Internet site or for which a generally accessible Internet site is maintained shall include a link on the front page of the agency's Internet site to the searchable budget database Web site.

"§ 147-33.124. Updates.

Effective July 1, 2012, the searchable budget database Web site shall be updated for each fiscal year not later than 30 days following the close of the fiscal year. In addition, the Director may update the searchable budget database Web site as new data becomes available. All State agencies shall provide to the Director all data that is required to be included in the searchable budget database Web site not later than 30 days after the data becomes available to the agency. The Director shall provide guidance to agency heads to ensure compliance with this section. By January 1, 2013, the Director shall add data for the budget for the 2009-2011 fiscal biennium to the searchable budget database Web site. Data for previous fiscal years may be added as available and as time permits. The Director shall ensure that all data added to the searchable budget database Web site remains accessible to the public for a minimum of 10 years.

The Director shall not be considered in compliance with this Article if the data required for the searchable budget database Web site is not available in a searchable and aggregate manner or the public is redirected to other government Web sites, unless each of those sites has information from all agencies and each category of information required can be searched electronically by field in a single search."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
