1                                   A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE TOWN OF FONTANA DAM.  
3 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

4                   **SECTION 1.** A Charter for the Town of Fontana Dam is enacted to read:

5                                   "CHARTER OF THE TOWN OF FONTANA DAM.

6                                   "ARTICLE I. INCORPORATION AND CORPORATE POWERS.

7                   "Section 1.1. **Incorporation and Corporate Powers.** The inhabitants of the Town of  
8 Fontana Dam are a body corporate and politic under the name 'Town of Fontana Dam.' The  
9 Town of Fontana Dam has all the powers, duties, rights, privileges, and immunities conferred  
10 and imposed on cities by the general laws of North Carolina.

11                                   "ARTICLE II. CORPORATE BOUNDARIES.

12                   "Section 2.1. **Town Boundaries.** Until modified in accordance with law, the boundaries of  
13 the Town of Fontana Dam are as follows:

14                   A tract of land located at Fontana Village in the Yellow Creek Township of Graham  
15 County, State of North Carolina, approximately 1.25 miles southwest of Fontana Dam, and  
16 more particularly described as follows: BEGINNING at a metal marker (Coordinates: N  
17 646,225; E 559,660) on the west side of Fontana Village at a common corner of the land of the  
18 United States of America (Tennessee Valley Authority), the land of the Whiting Manufacturing  
19 Company and the land previously transferred in fee by the Tennessee Valley Authority to the  
20 United States Department of Agriculture under the designation of Tract XTFR-4. From the  
21 initial point with the boundary line of the land in custody of the Tennessee Valley Authority, N  
22 67-32 E 2,818 feet passing a metal marker at 552 feet and a metal marker at the east edge of a  
23 road at 1,193 feet to a metal marker; thence, N 25-15 E 2,429 feet passing a metal marker at  
24 1,831 feet to a metal marker; thence, N 77-06 E 1,603 feet crossing State Highway 28 at  
25 approximately 65 feet to a metal marker; thence, S 45-31 E 1,480 feet to a metal marker;  
26 thence, S 22-32 E 846 feet recrossing State Highway 28 at approximately 775 feet to a metal  
27 marker; thence, S 56-26 W 3,594 feet to a metal marker; thence, S 85-25 W 602 feet to a metal  
28 marker; thence, S 77-16 W 1,470 feet to a metal marker; thence, due south, 303 feet to a metal  
29 marker; thence, N 89-28 W 1,504 feet to a metal marker; thence, N 03-26 W 836 feet to the  
30 point of BEGINNING, containing 288.5 acres, more or less.

31                                   "ARTICLE III. GOVERNING BODY.

32                   "Section 3.1. **Structure of Governing Body; Number of Members.** The governing body  
33 of the Town of Fontana Dam is the Mayor and the Town Council, which shall have four  
34 members.



1 "Section 3.2. **Temporary Officers.** Until the organizational meeting after the initial  
2 election in 2011 provided for by Section 4.2 of this Charter, Tammy Dees is appointed Mayor  
3 and Tim Gamble, Craig Litz, Vanessa Litz, and Debbie Rich are appointed council members of  
4 the Town of Fontana Dam, and they shall possess and exercise the powers granted to the Mayor  
5 and governing body until their successors are elected or appointed and qualified pursuant to this  
6 Charter. The temporary officers shall elect a person to serve as Interim Mayor Pro Tempore. If  
7 any person named in this section is unable to serve, the remaining temporary officers shall, by  
8 majority vote, appoint a person to serve until the initial election is held in 2011.

9 "Section 3.3. **Manner of Electing Town Council; Term of Office.** The qualified voters of  
10 the entire Town shall elect the members of the Town Council, and they shall serve for a term of  
11 two years or until their successors are elected and qualified.

12 "Section 3.4. **Manner of Electing Mayor; Term of Office; Duties.** The qualified voters of  
13 the entire Town shall elect the Mayor, who shall serve for a term of two years or until the  
14 Mayor's successor is elected and qualified. The Mayor shall attend and preside over meetings  
15 of the Town Council, shall advise the Town Council from time to time as to matters involving  
16 the Town of Fontana Dam, and shall have the right to vote as a member of the Town Council  
17 on all matters before the Town Council but shall have no right to break a tie vote in which the  
18 Mayor has participated. In the case of a vacancy in the office of Mayor, the remaining members  
19 of the Town Council shall choose from their own number a successor for the unexpired term.

20 "Section 3.5. **Manner of Electing Mayor Pro Tempore; Term of Office; Duties.** The  
21 Mayor Pro Tempore shall be elected from among the members of the Town Council at the  
22 organizational meeting after the initial election in 2011 and shall serve for a term of two years.  
23 The Mayor Pro Tempore shall act in the absence or disability of the Mayor. If the Mayor and  
24 Mayor Pro Tempore are both absent from a meeting of the Town Council, the members of the  
25 Town Council present may elect a temporary chair to preside in the absence. The Mayor Pro  
26 Tempore shall have the right to vote on all matters before the Town Council and shall be  
27 considered a member of the Town Council for all purposes.

#### 28 "ARTICLE IV. ELECTIONS.

29 "Section 4.1. **Conduct of Town Elections.** Elections shall be conducted on a nonpartisan  
30 basis and results determined by a plurality as provided in G.S. 163-292.

31 "Section 4.2. **Date of Election.** Elections shall be conducted in accordance with Chapter  
32 163 of the General Statutes, with the first regular municipal election to be held on November 8,  
33 2011.

34 "Section 4.3. **Special Elections and Referenda.** Special elections and referenda may be  
35 held only as provided by general law or applicable local acts of the General Assembly.

#### 36 "ARTICLE V. ORGANIZATION AND ADMINISTRATION.

37 "Section 5.1. **Form of Government.** The Town shall operate under the council-manager  
38 form of government as provided in Part 2 of Article 7 of Chapter 160A of the General Statutes.

39 "Section 5.2. **Town Attorney.** The Town Council shall appoint a Town Attorney licensed  
40 to practice law in North Carolina. It shall be the duty of the Town Attorney to represent the  
41 Town, advise Town officials, and perform other duties as required by law or as directed by the  
42 Town Council. The Town Attorney shall serve at the pleasure of the Town Council.

43 "Section 5.3. **Town Clerk.** The Town Council shall appoint a Town Clerk who shall  
44 perform duties as required by law or as directed by the Town Council. The Town Clerk shall  
45 serve at the pleasure of the Town Council.

#### 46 "ARTICLE VI. TAXES AND BUDGET ORDINANCE.

47 "Section 6.1. **Powers of the Town Council.** The Town Council may levy those taxes and  
48 fees authorized by general law. An affirmative vote equal to a majority of all the members of  
49 the Town Council shall be required to change the ad valorem tax rate from the rate established  
50 during the prior fiscal year.

1 "Section 6.2. **Commencement of Tax Collection.** From and after July 1, 2011, the citizens  
2 and property in the Town of Fontana Dam shall be subject to municipal taxes levied for the  
3 year beginning July 1, 2011, and for that purpose the Town shall obtain from Graham County a  
4 record of property in the area herein incorporated which was listed for property taxes as of  
5 January 1, 2011.

6 "Section 6.3. **Budget.** The Town may adopt a budget ordinance for fiscal year 2011-2012  
7 without following the timetable in the Local Government Budget and Fiscal Control Act but  
8 shall follow the sequence of actions in the spirit of the act insofar as is practical. For fiscal year  
9 2011-2012, ad valorem taxes may be paid at par or face amount within 90 days of adoption of  
10 the budget ordinance and thereafter in accordance with the schedule in G.S. 105-360 as if the  
11 taxes had been due and payable on September 1, 2011. If the effective date of the incorporation  
12 is prior to July 1, 2011, the Town may adopt a budget ordinance for fiscal year 2010-2011  
13 without following the timetable in the Local Government Budget and Fiscal Control Act but  
14 shall follow the sequence of actions in the spirit of the act insofar as practical. No ad valorem  
15 taxes may be levied for the 2010-2011 fiscal year.

16 "ARTICLE VII. ORDINANCES.

17 "Section 7.1. **Ordinances.** Except as otherwise provided in this Charter, the Town of  
18 Fontana Dam is authorized to adopt such ordinances as the Town Council deems necessary for  
19 the governance of the Town."

20 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
