A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- AN ACT TO AMEND THE DEFINITION OF RETIREMENT TO CLARIFY THAT
 SERVICE AS AN UNPAID VOLUNTEER IS NOT CONSIDERED SERVICE FOR THE
 PURPOSE OF THAT DEFINITION.
- 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
 - **SECTION 1.** G.S. 135-1(20) reads as rewritten:
- 7 "(20) "Retirement" means the termination of employment and the complete 8 separation from active service with no intent or agreement, express or 9 implied, to return to service. A retirement allowance under the provisions of 10 this Chapter may only be granted upon retirement of a member. In order for a member's retirement to become effective in any month, the member must 11 render no service, including part-time, temporary, substitute, or contractor 12 service, at any time during the six months immediately following the 13 effective date of retirement. For purposes of this subdivision, service as a 14 15 member of a school board or as an unpaid bona fide volunteer in a local school administrative unit shall not be considered service." 16 17 SECTION 2. This act is effective from and after March 24, 2009.
