2	AN ACT TO AMEND THE DEFINITION OF RETIREMENT TO CLARIFY THAT
3	SERVICE AS A VOLUNTEER GUARDIAN AD LITEM IN THE GUARDIAN AD
4	LITEM PROGRAM OR AS A VOLUNTEER FOR A STATE HISTORICAL AND
5	CULTURAL ORGANIZATION IS NOT CONSIDERED SERVICE FOR THE PURPOSE
6	OF THAT DEFINITION.
7	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
8	SECTION 1. G.S. 135-1(20) reads as rewritten:
9	"(20) "Retirement" means the termination of employment and the complete
10	separation from active service with no intent or agreement, express or
11	implied, to return to service. A retirement allowance under the provisions of
12	this Chapter may only be granted upon retirement of a member. In order for
13	a member's retirement to become effective in any month, the member must
14	render no service, including part-time, temporary, substitute, or contractor
15	service, at any time during the six months immediately following the
16	effective date of retirement. For purposes of this subdivision, service as a
17	member of a school board board, or as an unpaid bona fide volunteer in a
18	local school administrative unit unit, as an unpaid bona fide volunteer
19	Guardian ad Litem in the Guardian ad Litem Program, or as an unpaid bona
20	fide volunteer for a State historical and cultural organization shall not be
21	considered service. For purposes of this subdivision, an unpaid bona fide
22	volunteer for a State historical and cultural organization is prohibited from
23	volunteering for a position in which the individual was previously
24	employed."
25	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2011.
