11	The Division shall develop standards for a New Driver decal that will alert operators of						
12	motor vehicles on the public streets and highways and public vehicular areas of this State that a						
13	new driver is operating a vehicle and thereby instilling confidence in the new driver and						
14	allowing an experienced driver to give the new driver a safe distance for vehicle operation. The						
15	New Driver decal shall be designed to integrate bright optical colors that alert passing motorists						
16	in the daytime and an LED light system that will alert passing motorists during the nighttime.						
17	The Division shall determine the standards for shape and size based on visibility and weather						
18 19	conditions that may occur during the daytime and nighttime. The colors used in the New Driver						
20	decal shall not be amber, blue, red, or white. A person required to have a New Driver decal on a vehicle shall bear the cost of the New Driver decal. "
