1    A SENATE RESOLUTION COMMEMORATING THE 100<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY OF THE  
2        BIRTH OF PRESIDENT RONALD REAGAN.

3            Whereas, President Ronald Wilson Reagan, a man of humble background, worked  
4 throughout his life serving freedom and advancing the public good, having been employed as  
5 an entertainer, Union leader, corporate spokesman, Governor of California, and President of the  
6 United States; and

7            Whereas, Ronald Reagan served with honor and distinction for two terms as the 40<sup>th</sup>  
8 President of the United States of America; and

9            Whereas, during Mr. Reagan's presidency, he worked in a bipartisan manner to  
10 enact his bold agenda of restoring accountability and common sense to government, which led  
11 to an unprecedented economic expansion and opportunity for millions of Americans; and

12           Whereas, President Reagan's commitment to our Armed Forces contributed to the  
13 restoration of pride in America, her values and those cherished by the free world, and prepared  
14 America's Armed Forces to meet 21<sup>st</sup> Century challenges; and

15           Whereas, President Reagan's vision of "peace through strength" led to the end of the  
16 Cold War and the ultimate demise of the Soviet Union, guaranteeing basic human rights for  
17 millions of people; and

18           Whereas, February 6, 2011, was the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Ronald Reagan's birth and  
19 the seventh since his passing; Now, therefore,  
20 Be it resolved by the Senate:

21           **SECTION 1.** The Senate commemorates the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of President Ronald  
22 Reagan's birth on February 6, 1911, and does hereby honor his service to the United States of  
23 America and her people.

24           **SECTION 2.** The Senate urges all the citizens of North Carolina to take  
25 cognizance of the recent anniversary and to reflect on the contributions President Reagan made  
26 to this country.

27           **SECTION 3.** This resolution is effective upon adoption.
