managed by the State Treasurer.	
(b) Board members and employees of boards in the Department of the State T	
shall be considered State employees for purposes of Articles 31 and 31A of Chapter 14	
General Statutes. To the extent that the State Treasurer purchases commercial	
insurance coverage in excess of one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) per c	<u>laim for</u>
liability arising under Article 31 or 31A of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes, the pr	ovisions
of G.S. 143-299.4 shall not apply. To the extent that the State Treasurer purchases con	<u>nmercial</u>
