The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
SECTION 1. Study. – The Revenue Laws Study Committee shall study methods of		
providing tax benefits in a manner and in an amount that effectively offset tuition expenses so		
as to allow families of low- or moderate-income the opportunity to send their children to		
nonpublic schools or to public schools that charge tuition. The Committee shall make a report		
on this issue, including any recommendations or legislative proposals, to the 2012 Regular		
Session of the 2011 General Assembly upon its convening.		
SECTION 2. In conducting the study described in Section 1 of this act, the		
Revenue Laws Study Committee cochairs are authorized to appoint an advisory subcommittee		
and to ask the Local Government Commission to designate an individual to participate in the		
subcommittee's deliberations in an ex officio, nonvoting capacity. The subcommittee may		
consist of no more than 10 members and may include no more than four individuals who are		
not members of the Committee or of the General Assembly.		
SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
