2 AN ACT TO REPEAL A LOCAL ACT CONCERNING FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE BY
3 MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY SINCE A
4 GENERAL LAW NOW PROVIDES FOR AN ETHICS POLICY.

Whereas, pursuant to the mandate of G.S. 160A-86 requiring local governing boards adopt a Code of Ethics by December 31, 2010, the Orange County Board of Commissioners adopted a Code of Ethics on June 1, 2010; and

Whereas, included in the adopted Code of Ethics are disclosure requirements for the Orange County Commissioners substantially similar to those mandated by Chapter 460 of the 1987 Session Laws; and

Whereas, it is unduly burdensome to Orange County to be the sole county subject to disclosure requirements both pursuant to a local act and general law; Now, therefore,

13 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

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**SECTION 1.** Title VII of Chapter 460 of the 1987 Session Laws, being Sections 19 through 26 of that act, is repealed.

**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
