2 AN ACT TO MAKE CHANGES TO THE AVERASBORO TOWNSHIP TOURISM3 DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** Chapter 142 of the 1987 Session Laws, as amended by Part XII of 6 S.L. 2001-439, reads as rewritten:

7 "Section 1. Occupancy Tax. – (a) Authorization and Scope. – The Harnett County Board of 8 Commissioners may levy a room occupancy tax in an amount not to exceed three percent (3%) 9 of the gross receipts derived from the rental of any room, lodging, or similar accommodation 10 furnished by a hotel, motel, inn, or similar place within Averasboro Township that is subject to 11 sales tax imposed by the State under G.S.105-164.4(a)(3). This tax is in addition to any State or 12 local sales tax. This tax does not apply to accommodations furnished by nonprofit charitable, 13 educational, or religious institutions or organizations.

14 (a1) Additional Occupancy Tax. - In addition to the tax authorized by subsection (a) of this section, the Harnett County Board of Commissioners may levy a room occupancy tax of 15 16 three percent (3%) of the gross receipts derived from the rental of accommodations taxable 17 under that subsection. The county may not levy a tax under this section unless it also levies the tax under subsection (a) of this section. A tax levied under this section may not become 18 19 effective before the first day of the second month after the resolution levying the tax is adopted. 20 The levy, collection, administration, and repeal of the tax authorized by this subsection shall be 21 in accordance with this section.

22 (b) Repealed.

(c) Administration. – For the purpose of levying and administering the tax authorized by this act, Averasboro Township shall be a body politic and corporate and shall have the power to carry out the provisions of this act. The Harnett County Board of Commissioners shall serve, ex officio, as the governing body of the Township, and the officers of the board of commissioners shall serve as the officers of the governing body of the township. A simple majority of the governing body constitutes a quorum, and approval by a majority of those present is sufficient to determine any matter before the governing body, if a quorum is present.

The Harnett County Board of Commissioners, as the governing body of Averasboro Township, shall administer a tax levied under this act. A tax levied under this act shall be levied, administered, collected, and repealed as provided in G.S. 153A-155 as if Averasboro Township were a county. The penalties provided in G.S. 153A-155 apply to a tax levied under this act.

1 The members appointed by the board of commissioners shall serve for a term of one year; 2 vacancies Vacancies shall be filled in the same manner as the initial appointments. All of the 3 members, including those who serve ex officio, shall be voting members of the Authority. A 4 majority of the members shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business and an 5 affirmative vote of the majority of the members present at a meeting of the Authority shall be 6 required to constitute action of the Authority. The board of commissioners Authority shall 7 designate one member of the Authority as chair and one member of the Authority to serve as 8 vice-chair and shall determine the compensation, if any, to be paid to members of the 9 Authority. 10 The Authority shall meet monthly or at the call of the chair and shall adopt rules of

procedure to govern its meetings. The Finance Officer for Harnett County the City of Dunn shall be the ex officio finance officer of the Authority.

13 (b) Duties. — The authority shall develop, promote, and advertise travel and tourism in 14 Averasboro Township, sponsor tourist-oriented events and activities for Averasboro Township, 15 operate and maintain museums and historic sites throughout Averasboro Township, and 16 purchase, operate, and-maintain a convention facility for Averasboro Township. Township, and 17 finance tourist-related capital projects in Averasboro Township.

18 (c) Reports. — The Authority shall report quarterly and at the close of the fiscal year to 19 the board of county commissioners on its receipts and expenditures for the preceding quarter 20 and for the year in such detail as the board may require.

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"Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to the distribution of the net proceeds of the occupancy tax on or after the earlier of October 1, 2014, or the date specified in a resolution adopted in accordance with this act.
