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2	AN ACT TO CREATE THE CHARLOTTE REGIONAL AIRPORT AUTHORITY.
3	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
4	SECTION 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Charlotte Regional
5	Airport Authority Act."
6	SECTION 2. There is hereby created the Charlotte Regional Airport Authority,
7	which shall be a body corporate and politic, having the powers, authority, and jurisdiction
8	hereinafter enumerated and such other and additional powers and authority as shall be
9	conferred upon it by future acts of the General Assembly.
10	SECTION 3. Unless the context requires otherwise, the following definitions apply
11	throughout this act to the defined words and phrases and their cognates:
12	(1) Airport facilities. – Airport facilities of all kinds, including, but not limited
13	to, landing fields, hangars, fixed base operations, shops, restaurants and
14	catering facilities, terminals, buildings, automobile parking facilities and all
15	other facilities necessary, beneficial, and/or helpful for the landing, taking
16	off, operating, servicing, repairing, and parking of aircraft, the loading,
17	unloading, and handling of cargo and mail, express and freight, and the
18	accommodation, convenience, and comfort of crews and passengers,
19	together with related transportation facilities, all necessary, beneficial,
20	and/or helpful appurtenances, machinery, and equipment, and all lands,
21	properties, rights, easements, and franchises relating thereto and considered

- and/or helpful appurchances, machinery, and equipment, and an failus, properties, rights, easements, and franchises relating thereto and considered necessary, beneficial, and/or helpful by the Authority in connection therewith.
 (2) CAAC member A member of the Charlette Airport Advisory Committee
- (2) CAAC member. A member of the Charlotte Airport Advisory Committee in existence when this act becomes law.
- (3) Authority. The Charlotte Regional Airport Authority created by this act or, if such Authority is abolished, the authority, board, body, commission, or other entity succeeding to the principal functions thereof.
- 29 (4) Member. An individual who is appointed to the Authority as provided by
 30 this act.

31 **SECTION 4.** The Authority shall consist of eleven members. The appointing 32 authorities are encouraged to appoint members who, when practical, have experience in 33 aviation, logistics, construction and/or facilities management, law, accounting and/or finance. 34 The eleven members shall be appointed as follows:

1 **SECTION 7.(d)** Any lands acquired, owned, controlled, or occupied by the 2 Authority shall and/or are hereby declared to be acquired, owned, controlled, and occupied for 3 a public purpose.

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SECTION 7.(e) The Authority is not authorized to levy any tax.

5 **SECTION 7.(f)** Any claim by the City of Charlotte on account of acquisition of 6 property by the Authority is extinguished.

7 **SECTION 8.** The Authority shall make annual reports to the Cabarrus, Gaston, 8 Mecklenburg, and Union County Boards of Commissioners and the Charlotte City Council 9 setting forth a summary of its general operations and transactions conducted by it pursuant to 10 this act. The Authority shall be regarded as the corporate instrumentality and agent for 11 Cabarrus, Gaston, Mecklenburg, and Union Counties and the City of Charlotte for the purpose 12 of developing aviation facilities in the Counties of Cabarrus, Gaston, Mecklenburg, and Union, 13 but it shall have no power to pledge the credit of the Counties of Cabarrus, Gaston, 14 Mecklenburg, and Union or the City of Charlotte, or to impose any obligation upon those 15 counties, or the City of Charlotte, except and when such power is expressly granted by statute.

16 **SECTION 9.** All rights, powers, and authority given to the counties and/or 17 municipalities by the statutes of North Carolina, which may now be in effect, or which may be 18 enacted in the future, relating to the development, operation, maintenance, regulation, and/or 19 control of municipal or other governmental airports and the regulations of aircraft are hereby 20 vested in the Authority.

SECTION 10. The Authority is hereby expressly authorized to make and enter into contracts, leases, subleases, conveyances, and other agreements with any political subdivision, agency, department, or instrumentality of this State, any agency, department, or subdivision of the United States, or any other legal entity or person for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of this act.

26 **SECTION 11.** The powers of the Authority created by this act shall be construed 27 liberally in favor of the Authority. No listing of powers included in this act is intended to be 28 exclusive or restrictive, and the specific mention of, or failure to mention, particular powers in 29 this act shall not be construed as limiting in any way the general powers of the Authority as 30 stated in Section 6(a) of this act. It is the intent of this act to grant the Authority full power and 31 right to exercise all authority necessary for the effective operation and conduct of the 32 Authority. It is further intended that the Authority should have all implied powers necessary or 33 incidental to carrying out the expressed powers and the expressed purposes for which the 34 Authority is created. The fact that this act specifically states that the Authority possesses a 35 certain power does not mean that the Authority must exercise such power unless this act 36 specifically so requires.

37 SECTION 12. G.S. 66-58(a) shall not apply to the Charlotte Regional Airport
 38 Authority or a lessee or sublessee of the Charlotte Regional Airport Authority.

39 **SECTION 13.** If any provision of this act or its application is held invalid, the 40 invalidity does not affect other provisions or applications of this act that can be given effect 41 without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are 42 severable.

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SECTION 14. This act is effective when it becomes law.
