A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO DIRECT THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE OF THE COURTS TO DEVELOP
A WRITTEN, COMPREHENSIVE POLICY FOR THE MANAGEMENT OF
INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY RESOURCES, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE
LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COMMISSION'S COMMITTEE ON JUDICIAL
EFFICIENCY AND EFFECTIVE ADMINISTRATION OF JUSTICE.

7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

8 SECTION 1. The Administrative Office of the Courts shall develop a written, 9 comprehensive policy for the management of information technology resources that includes 10 specific guidelines for the distribution and maintenance of information technology hardware. 11 The Administrative Office of the Courts shall report on this policy to the Joint Legislative 12 Oversight Committee on Justice and Public Safety and the Joint Legislative Oversight 13 Committee on Information Technology by March 1, 2015.

14 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2014.
