8	SECTION 1. G.S. 20-296 reads as rewritten:
9	"§ 20-296. Notice and hearing upon denial, suspension, revocation or refusal to renew
10	license.
11	No license shall be suspended or revoked or denied, or renewal thereof refused, until a
12	written notice of the complaint made has been furnished to the licensee against whom the same
13	is directed, and a hearing thereon has been had before the Commissioner, or a person
14	designated by him. At least 10 days' written notice of the time and place of such hearing shall
15	be given to the licensee by certified mail with return receipt requested to his last known address
16	as shown on his license or other record of information in possession of the Division. At any
17	such hearing, the licensee shall have the right to be heard personally or by counsel. After
18	hearing, the Division shall have power to suspend, revoke or refuse to renew the license in
19	question. Immediate notice of any such action shall be given to the licensee in the manner
20	herein provided in the case of notices of hearing.accordance with G.S. 1A-1, Rule 4 of the
21	Rules of Civil Procedure."
