3	PLATES HAVE A "FIRST IN FLIGHT" BACKGROUND, AND TO AUTHORIZE THE							
4	DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO PRODUCE SPECIAL REGISTRATION							
5	PLATES FOR THE NATIVE BROOK TROUT AND RED DRUM.							
6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:							
7	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 20-63(b1) reads as rewritten:							
8	"(b1) The following special registration plates do not have to be a "First in Flight" plate as							
9	provided in subsection (b) of this section. The design of the plates that are not "First in Flight"							
10	plates must be approved by the Division and the State Highway Patrol for clarity and ease of							
11	identification. When the Division registers a vehicle or renews the registration of a vehicle on							
12	or after July 1, 2015, the Division must send the owner a replacement special license plate in a							
13	standardized format in accordance with subsection (b) of this section and G.S. 20-79.4(a3).
