- 3 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
- 4 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 7A-170 reads as rewritten:
- 5 "§ 7A-170. Nature of office and oath.oath; age limit for service.
- 6 (a) A magistrate is an officer of the district court. Before entering upon the duties of his 7 office, a magistrate shall take the oath of office prescribed for a magistrate of the General Court 8 of Justice. A magistrate possesses all the powers of his office at all times during his term.
- 9 (b) No magistrate may continue in office beyond the last day of the month in which the
- 10 magistrate reaches the mandatory retirement age for justices and judges of the General Court of 11 Justice specified in G.S. 7A-4.20."
- 12 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective October 1, 2013.
