1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL FLEXIBILITY TO CERTAIN LOCAL BOARDS OF
3	EDUCATION IN ADOPTING THE SCHOOL CALENDAR.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	SECTION 1. G.S. 115C-84.2(d) reads as rewritten:
6	"(d) Opening and Closing Dates. – Local boards of education shall determine the dates
7	of opening and closing the public schools under subdivision (a)(1) of this section. Except for
8	year-round schools, the opening date for students shall be no earlier than August 12.the
9	Monday closest to August 26, and the closing date for students shall be no later than the Friday
10	closest to June 11. On a showing of good cause, the State Board of Education may waive the
11	requirement that the opening date for students be no earlier than the Monday closest to August
12	26 and may allow the local board of education to set an opening date no earlier than the
13	Monday closest to August 19, to the extent that school calendars are able to provide sufficient
14	days to accommodate anticipated makeup days due to school closings. A local board may
15	revise the scheduled closing date if necessary in order to comply with the minimum
16	requirements for instructional days or instructional time. For purposes of this subsection, the
17	term "good cause" means that schools in any local school administrative unit in a county have
18	been closed eight days per year during any four of the last 10 years because of severe weather
19	conditions, energy shortages, power failures, or other emergency situations.
20	The required opening and closing dates under this subsection shall not apply to any school
21	that a local board designated as having a modified calendar for the 2003-2004 school year or to
22	any school that was part of a planned program in the 2003-2004 school year for a system of
23	modified calendar schools, so long as the school operates under a modified calendar."
24	SECTION 2. This act applies only to the Franklin County and Nash-Rocky Mount
25	school administrative units.
26	SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies beginning with
27	the 2013-2014 school year.
