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| 2 | AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF HIGH POINT TO LEVY A MOTOR VEHICLE |
| 3 | PRIVILEGE TAX OF UP TO TWENTY DOLLARS FOR EACH RESIDENT VEHICLE |
| 4 | LOCATED IN THE CITY. |
| 5 | The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: |
| 6 | SECTION 1. G.S. 20-97(b) reads as rewritten: |
| 7 | "(b) General Municipal Vehicle Tax. – Cities and towns may levy a tax of not more than |
| 8 | five dollars (\$5.00)twenty dollars (\$20.00) per year upon any vehicle resident in the city or |
| 9 | town. The proceeds of the tax up to fifteen dollars (\$15.00) may be used for any lawful |
| 10 | purpose. The proceeds of these taxes derived from any levy above fifteen dollars (\$15.00) and |
| 11 | up to twenty dollars (\$20.00) shall be used exclusively for transportation-related purposes, |
| 12 | including sidewalks." |
| 13 | SECTION 2. This act applies to the City of High Point only. |
| 14 | SECTION 3. This act is effective for taxes imposed for taxable years beginning on |
| 15 | or after July 1, 2013. This act does not affect the rights or liabilities of the State, a taxpayer, or |
| 16 | another person arising under a statute amended by this act before the effective date of its |
| 17 | amendment; nor does it affect the right to any refund or credit of a tax that accrued under the |

18 amended statute before the effective date of its amendment.



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
