A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO GIVE THE GOVERNOR LIMITED FLEXIBILITY TO REMOVE GUBERNATORIAL APPOINTEES TO BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS DURING THEIR TERMS OF OFFICE.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 128-7 reads as rewritten:

- "§ 128-7. Officer Service at the pleasure of Governor; Officer to hold until successor qualified.
- (a) The Governor may remove without cause during a calendar year not more than one-fourth of the members of a board or commission who are serving a fixed term of office. This subsection does not apply to board or commission members not appointed by the Governor.
- (b) All-Except if removed from office, all officers shall continue in their respective offices until their successors are elected or appointed, and duly qualified."

SECTION 2. G.S. 143B-13 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

- "(d1) As provided by G.S. 128-7(a) the Governor may remove without cause during a calendar year not more than one-fourth of the members of a board or commission who are serving a fixed term of office. This subsection does not apply to board or commission members not appointed by the Governor."
 - **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
