A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 AN ACT TO PROTECT NORTH CAROLINA TIMBER PRODUCERS BY REQUIRING 3 THAT SUSTAINABLE BUILDING STANDARDS NOT DISADVANTAGE OR 4 FORBID THE USE OF BUILDING MATERIALS PRODUCED IN THIS STATE.
- 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 143-135.37(b) reads as rewritten:

"§ 143-135.37. Energy and water use standards for public major facility construction and renovation projects; verification and reporting of energy and water use.

. . . 10 (b)Energy-Efficiency Standard. - For every major facility construction project of a public agency, the building shall be designed and constructed so that the calculated energy 11 consumption is at least thirty percent (30%) less than the energy consumption for the same 12 13 building as calculated using the energy-efficiency standard in ASHRAE 90.1-2004. For every major facility renovation project of a public agency, the renovated building shall be designed 14 and constructed so that the calculated energy consumption is at least twenty percent (20%) less 15 than the energy consumption for the same renovated building as calculated using the 16 energy-efficiency standard in ASHRAE 90.1-2004. To achieve sustainable building standards, 17 a construction project may utilize a nationally recognized high performance environmental 18 building rating system, provided that any such rating system (i) does not use a material or 19 20 product-based credit system disadvantaging materials or products manufactured or produced in 21 this State; (ii) gives certification credits equally to forest products grown, manufactured, and certified under the Sustainable Forestry Initiative, the American Tree Farm System, and the 22 Forest Stewardship Council; (iii) must be developed in conformity with American National 23 Standards Institute procedures; and (iv) must either be approved as American National 24 Standards or developed by a designator audited by the American National Standards Institute. 25 26 For the purposes of this subsection, any exception or special standard for a specific type of building found in ASHRAE 90.1-2004 is included in the ASHRAE 90.1-2004 standard." 27 28

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
