A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT ALLOWING LICENSED IRRIGATION CONTRACTORS TO INSTALL AND SERVICE BACKFLOW PREVENTION ASSEMBLIES. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. G.S. 89G-1(4) reads as rewritten: "§ 89G-1. Definitions. The following definitions apply in this Chapter:		
(4)	Irrigation system. – All piping, fittings, sprinklers, drip tubing, control wiring of 30 volts or less, and associated components instathed delivery and application of water for the purpose of irrigation downstream of a well, pond or other surface water, potable water source, or grey water source and downstream of a backflow prevention assembly. Water meter.
