Short Title: Study/Access to Credit. (Public) Representative Terry. Sponsors: Referred to: A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE STATE BANKING COMMISSION TO STUDY THE ISSUES RELATED TO PROVIDING ACCESS TO CREDIT TO PERSONS OF LOW- OR MODERATE-INCOME. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** The State Banking Commission shall study the issues related to providing access to credit to persons of low- or moderate-income. The study shall examine at least all of the following: (1) Research and determine the reasons preventing persons of low- or moderateincome from accessing credit, including the effects of any State or federal (2) Research and evaluate methods for providing low-cost access to credit to persons of low- or moderate-income, including the use of micro lending or alternative methods employed by other states. Research and evaluate what economic incentives spur financial institutions (3) to provide low-cost access to credit to persons of low- or moderate-income. Any other issues determined by the Commission to be relevant. (4) **SECTION 2.** The State Banking Commission shall report its findings and any recommendations, including any legislative recommendations, to the 2013 General Assembly when it reconvenes in 2014.

SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
