| 4 | SECTION 1. G.S. 7A-314(d) reads as rewritten: |
| 5 | "(d) AnSubject to the specific limitations set forth in G.S. 7A-305(d)(11), an expert |
| 6 | witness, other than a salaried State, county, or municipal law-enforcement officer, shall receive |
| 7 | such compensation and allowances as the court, or the Judicial Standards Commission, in its |
| 8 | discretion, may authorize. A law-enforcement officer who appears as an expert witness shall |
| 9 | receive reimbursement for travel expenses only, as provided in subsection (b) of this section. |
| 10 | Compensation of experts acting on behalf of the court or prosecutorial offices shall be paid in |
| 11 | accordance with the rules established by the Administrative Office of the Courts. |
| 12 | Compensation of experts provided under G.S. 7A-454 shall be in accordance with rules |
| 13 | established by the Office of Indigent Defense Services." |
| 14 | SECTION 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 2013, and applies to motions |
| 15 | or applications for costs filed on or after that date. |



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
