13		(3) "Brownfields property" or "brownfields site" means abandoned, idled, or		
14		underused property at which expansion or redevelopment is hindered by		
15		actual environmental contamination or the possibility of environmental		
16		contamination and that is or may be subject to remediation under any State		
17		remedial program other than Part 2A of Article 21A of Chapter 143 of the		
18		General Statutes or that is or may be subject to remediation under the		
19		Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act		
20		of 1980, as amended (42 U.S.C. § 9601, et seq.) except for a site listed on		
21		the National Priorities List pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 9605.

23		(11) "Regulated substance" means a hazardous waste, as defined in G.S		
24		130A-290; a hazardous substance, as defined in G.S. 143-215.77A; oil, as		
25		defined in G.S. 143-215.77; or other substance regulated under any remedial		
26		program implemented by the Department other than Part 2A of Article 21A		
27		of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes. Department.

29		SECTION 2. The Department of Environment and Natural Resources shall report		
30	to the Environmental Review Commission no later than April 1, 2014, regarding the impact of			
31	this act on the Brownfields Property Reuse program and the Leaking Petroleum Underground			
32	Storage Ta	nk Cleanup program.
