A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT PROTECTING THE RIGHT-TO-WORK BY MAKING IT AN UNENFORCEABLE UNFAIR TRADE PRACTICE FOR ANY CONTRACT TO REQUIRE A CONTRACTOR OR SUBCONTRACTOR TO USE UNIONIZED LABOR. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** Article 1 of Chapter 75 is amended by adding a new section to read:

## "§ 75-43. Contract provision relating to union membership of contractor's employees is void and unenforceable.

- (a) Any provision in any agreement or contract that would require a contractor or subcontractor to employ union members for performance of an agreement or contract is void and unenforceable as a matter of public policy as set forth in G.S. 95-78.
- (b) It is an unfair trade practice under G.S. 75-1.1 to require a contractor or subcontractor to employ union members for performance of an agreement or contract.
  - (c) This section applies to agreements or contracts performed in this State.
- (d) This section does not apply to an agreement or contract paid, in whole or in part, with federal funds."
  - **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to agreements or contracts entered into on or after that date.
