6	SECTION 1. G.S. 115C-81 is amended by adding new subsections to read:	
7	"(k) Cursive Writing. – The standard course of study shall include the requirement that	
8	the public schools provide instruction in cursive writing so that students create readable	
9	documents through legible cursive handwriting by the end of fifth grade.	
10	<u>(1)</u> <u>M</u>	ultiplication Tables. – The standard course of study shall include the requirement
11	that students enrolled in public schools memorize multiplication tables to demonstrate	
12	competency in efficiently multiplying numbers."	
13	SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies beginning with	
14	the 2013-2014 school year.
