The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
SE	ECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of the State Building	ng Code or any
public or local law to the contrary, including, but not limited to, Article 9 of Chapter 143 of the		
General Statutes, requirements for seismic upgrades to Occupancy Category IV shall not apply		
to structures occupied by an emergency preparedness communications and operations center		
for a period of less than five years while the structure ordinarily occupied by the center is		
undergoing seismic upgrades to Occupancy Category IV.		
SECTION 2. This act applies to Forsyth County only		

**SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law and expires June 30, 2018.
