

10	<b>SECTION 1.1.</b> The appropriations made in this act are for maximum amounts necessary to provide the services and accomplish the purposes described in the budget in
12	accordance with the State Budget Act. Savings shall be affected where the total amounts
13	appropriated are not required to perform these services and accomplish these purposes, and the
14	savings shall revert to the appropriate fund at the end of each fiscal year, except as otherwise
15	provided by law.

18	<b>SECTION 1.2.</b> This act shall be known as the "Current Operations and Capital
19	Improvements Appropriations Act of 2013."
