SECTION 1. Article 4 of Chapter 20 of the General Statutes is amended by addin
a new section to read:
"§ 20-187.4. Secondary employment.
A member of the State Highway Patrol, subject to the approval of his or her commanding
officer, shall be allowed to engage in any secondary employment that does not directly o
indirectly create a conflict of interest with the Patrol or impair the member's ability to perform
all expected duties. Permitted types of secondary employment include providing security a
sporting events and providing security for events benefitting elementary and secondary school
and institutions of higher learning. Nothing in this section shall be construed to allow a member
to engage in secondary employment that requires the member to testify in court or make arrests
The Secretary of Public Safety shall adopt orders, rules, and regulations that are consistent with
