A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO CLARIFY THAT THE DEFINITION OF "RESTAURANT" UNDER THE ALCOHOL BEVERAGE CONTROL LAWS INCLUDES AN ESTABLISHMENT THAT PRIMARILY PREPARES AND SERVES DESSERTS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. G.S. 18B-1000(6) reads as rewritten: '\$ 18B-1000. Definitions concerning establishments. The following requirements and definitions shall apply to this Chapter:		
 (6	 Restaurant. – An establishment substantially engaged in the preparing and serving meals.meals, desserts, or both. To restaurant, an establishment's gross receipts from food and beverages shall be not less than thirty percent (30%) of the receipts from food, nonalcoholic beverages, and alcoholic berestaurant shall also have a kitchen and an inside dining area wi at least 36 people. 	qualify as a nonalcoholic e total gross beverages.
