2	AN ACT TO ALLOW THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO INCREASE THE
3	SPEED LIMIT ON CERTAIN INTERSTATE HIGHWAYS TO A MAXIMUM OF
4	SEVENTY-FIVE MILES PER HOUR.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 20-141(d)(2) reads as rewritten:

- 7 "(d) Whenever the Department of Transportation determines on the basis of an (1)8 engineering and traffic investigation that any speed allowed by subsection 9 (b) is greater than is reasonable and safe under the conditions found to exist upon any part of a highway outside the corporate limits of a municipality or 10 upon any part of a highway designated as part of the Interstate Highway 11 System or any part of a controlled-access highway (either inside or outside 12 the corporate limits of a municipality), the Department of Transportation 13 shall determine and declare a reasonable and safe speed limit. 14
- Whenever the Department of Transportation determines on the basis of an 15 (2)engineering and traffic investigation that a higher maximum speed than 16 those set forth in subsection (b) is reasonable and safe under the conditions 17 found to exist upon any part of a highway designated as part of the Interstate 18 Highway System or any part of a controlled-access highway (either inside or 19 outside the corporate limits of a municipality) the Department of 20 Transportation shall determine and declare a reasonable and safe speed limit. 21 22 A speed limit set pursuant to this subsection may not exceed 7075 miles per 23 hour.
- Speed limits set pursuant to this subsection are not effective until appropriate signs giving notice thereof are erected upon the parts of the highway affected."
- 26 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
