12	agency for violation of the law, the burden of showing that the person who was fined actually	
13	committed th	e act for which the fine or penalty was imposed rests with the State agency.
14	<u>(c)</u> <u>T</u>	he burden of showing that a career State employee subject to Chapter 126 of the
15	General Stat	ites was discharged, suspended, or demoted for just cause rests with the agency
16	employer."	
17	S	ECTION 2. The Joint Legislative Administrative Procedure Oversight Committee
18	shall study w	whether there are other categories of contested cases in which the burden of proof
19	should be pla	ced with the agency.
20	S	ECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to contested
21	cases comme	nced on or after that date.
