13	<u>(1)</u>	Electronic filing means the electronic transmission of the petition, notice of	
14		hearing, pleadings, or any other documents filed in a contested case with the	
15		Office of Administrative Hearings, as further defined by rules adopted by the	
16		Office of Administrative Hearings.	
17	<u>(2)</u>	Electronic Filing Service Provider (EFSP) means the service provided by the	
18		Office of Administrative Hearings for e-filing and e-service of documents	
19		via the Internet.	
20	<u>(3)</u>	Electronic service means the electronic transmission of the petition, notice of	
21		hearing, pleadings, or any other documents in a contested case, as further	
22		defined by rules adopted by the Office of Administrative Hearings."	
23		<b>FION 2.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to contested	
24	cases filed on or	after that date.
