## **BILL SUMMARY:**

Repeals Section 1(d) of SL 2011-141. Amends paragraphs 1 and 2 of Section 12A of Chapter 232 of the Private Laws of 1927, as amended, restoring the election date for Mayor and City Council to the Tuesday after the first Monday in November, pursuant to G.S. 163-279(a)(2) (previously, elections were scheduled as provided for in Section 12J of the Private Laws of 1927). Amends Section 12B.2 of Chapter 232 of the Private Laws of 1927, as amended, establishing the election time for primaries as the first primary will be held on the second Tuesday after Labor Day, and the second primary, if required, will be held on the fourth Tuesday before the election, pursuant to G.S. 163-279(a)(2), (previously, primaries were scheduled as provided for in Section 12J of the Private Laws of 1927). Makes technical and conforming changes.
