1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE NAMES AND ADDRESSES OF PERSONS EXCUSED
3	FROM JURY DUTY BASED ON DISQUALIFICATION SHALL BE RETAINED BY
4	THE CLERK OF SUPERIOR COURT FOR NOT LESS THAN TWO YEARS.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	SECTION 1. Article 1 of Chapter 9 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a
7	new section to read:
8	"§ 9-6.2. Records of excusals from jury duty based on disqualification.
9	The name and address of each person who requests to be excused from jury duty on the
10	basis that he or she is not qualified to serve as a juror under G.S. 9-3, along with the reason for
11	that request, shall be retained by the clerk of superior court for not less than two years from the
12	date of excusal but are not public record."
13	<b>SECTION 2.</b> G.S. 9-6(e) reads as rewritten:
14	"(e) The judge shall inform the clerk of superior court of persons excused under this
15	section, and the clerk shall keep a record of excuses separate from the master jury list.list in
16	accordance with G.S. 9-6.2."
17	<b>SECTION 3.</b> This act becomes effective July 1, 2016.
