20	(c) <u>Parking. – The Department, and any other owner or operator of a transportation facility</u>	
21	funded in whole or in part by State or local funds, shall make reasonable accommodations for	
22	motorcycle parking at transportation facilities. The term "reasonable accommodations" includes	
23	sectioning portions of an existing parking space where the size configuration of the parking space	
24	does not meet building code requirements for full-size motor vehicles. Nothing in this subsection	
25	shall be construed as requiring the structural or technological modification of parking structures	
26	constructed or substantially completed on or before July 1, 2016.	
27	(d) <u>Construction. – Nothing in this section shall be construed as altering or superseding</u>	
28	any State or federal law that prohibits or imposes a requirement, or has the effect of prohibiting of	
29	imposing a requirement, that applies only to a motorcyclist."	
30	SECTION 2. There is appropriated from the Highway Fund to the Department o	
31	Transportation the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) in nonrecurring funds for the 2016-2017	
32	fiscal year to be used to fund costs incurred by the Department in implementing this act.	
33	SECTION 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2016.
