4	SECTION 1. G.S. 53C-1-4(58) reads as rewritten:		
5	"(58) Public member A member of the Commission who is not a pra	ctical	
6	banker orbanker, a consumer finance licensee licensee, or a person licensee licensee.	ensed	
7	under Article 19B of Chapter 53 of the General Statutes and who is a

11	SECTION 2. G.S. 53C-2-1(a) reads as rewritten:		
12	"(a) The Commission consists of 15 members, including the State Treasurer, who		
13	serve as an ex officio member; 12 members appointed by the Governor; and two mer		
14	appointed by the General Assembly under G.S. 120-121, one of whom shall be appointed	-	
15	the recommendation of the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and one of whom sha		
16	appointed upon the recommendation of the Speaker of the House of Representatives		
17	Governor shall appoint three practical bankers, one consumer finance licensee, <u>one p</u>

20	members to the Commission. The member appointed upon the recommendation or President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall be a practical banker, and the member appo

23	terms on the Commission. Any vacancy occurring in the membership of the Commission		
24	be filled by the appropriate appointing officer for the unexpired term, except that vaca

26	G.S. 120-122. The appointed members of the Commission shall receive subsistence and the		
27	expenses at the rates set forth in G.S. 120-3.1. This compensation shall be paid from		
28	revenues of the OCOB."		
29	SECTION 3. When the changes to G.S. 53C-2-1, as enacted by Section 2 o	f this	
30	act, become effective, the position on the Commission held by Donald E. Fader shall conv		
31	a position assigned for a licensee under Article 19B of Chapter 53 of the General Sta	tutes.	
32	Donald E. Fader shall continue on the Commission as the designated licensee under A	rticle	
33	19B of Chapter 53 of the General Statutes for his remaining term, which is scheduled to e	xpire	
34	April 1, 2017, or until he resigns or ceases to meet the definition of a licensee under A		
35	19B of Chapter 53 of the General Statutes, whichever occurs first. The terms of the rema	ining
