Whereas, the Autumn Leaves Festival, held annually in the Town of Mount Airy, is one of the longest-running events in the State; and Whereas, the Festival began as a celebration of the end of the tobacco and apple harvesting season, and is now in its 49th year; and Whereas, the Festival attracts over 200,000 visitors over a three-day weekend in October of each year and provides fun activities for the entire family; and Whereas, the Festival showcases the State's rich musical heritage with local musicians performing styles that include old-time, bluegrass, and gospel; and Whereas, over 200 artisans demonstrate their talents and skills passed down for generations through unique arts and crafts; and Whereas, attendees can sample "Food for the Soul," served with hospitality by local civic and service organizations; and Whereas, the Festival consistently ranks as one of the "Top 20 Events" in the Southeast by the Southeast Tourism Society; and Whereas, the State does not have an official fall festival; Now, therefore,
