| 3 | BREED-SPECIFIC ORDINANCES REGULATING DOGS OR DOG OWNERSHIP. |
| 4 | The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: |
| 5 | SECTION 1. G.S. 67-4.5 reads as rewritten: |
| 6 | "§ 67-4.5. Local ordinances. ordinances; no breed-specific regulation. |
| 7 | (a) Nothing-Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, nothing in this Article |
| 8 | shall be construed to prevent a city or county from adopting or enforcing its own program for |
| 9 | control of dangerous dogs. |
| 10 | (b) No unit of local government may adopt an ordinance regulating, restricting, or |
| 11 | prohibiting the possession of dogs based upon the breed of the dogs or upon presumptions |
| 12 | about the behavior inherent to a particular breed of dog." |
| 13 | SECTION 2. G.S. 153A-131 reads as rewritten: |
| 14 | "§ 153A-131. Possession or harboring of dangerous animals. |
| 15 | ASubject to the prohibition contained in G.S. 67-4.5(b), a county may by ordinance |
| 16 | regulate, restrict, or prohibit the possession or harboring of animals which are dangerous to |
| 17 | persons or property. No such ordinance shall have the effect of permitting any activity or |
| 18 | condition with respect to a wild animal which is prohibited or more severely restricted by |
| 19 | regulations of the Wildlife Resources Commission." |
| 20 | SECTION 3. G.S. 160A-186 reads as rewritten: |
| 21 | "§ 160A-186. Regulation of domestic animals. |
| 22 | ASubject to the prohibition contained in G.S. 67-4.5(b), a city may by ordinance regulate, |
| 23 | restrict, or prohibit the keeping, running, or going at large of any domestic animals, including |
| 24 | dogs and cats. The ordinance may provide that animals allowed to run at large in violation of |
| 25 | the ordinance may be seized and sold or destroyed after reasonable efforts to notify their |
| 26 | owner." |
| 27 | SECTION 4. This act is effective when it becomes law. |
