5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	SECTION 1. G.S. 105-164.4G(f) is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:
7	"(f) Exemptions. – The following gross receipts derived from an admission charge to an
8	entertainment activity are specifically exempt from the tax imposed by this Article:
9	
10	(6) A commercial agricultural fair that meets the requirements of
11	G.S. 106-520.1, as determined by the Commissioner of Agriculture."
12	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective May 1, 2015, and applies to gross receipts
13	derived on or after that date.
