5 6 7 (a) Data obtained by an automatic license plate reader system shall not be preserved for more than 90 days unless there is a written, articulable, and recorded basis that the data has intelligence or investigatory value or is or may become evidence in a specific criminal action. In that event, the specific case and parties involved shall be identified.

Data shall not be disclosed except to a federal, State, or local law enforcement agency for a legitimate law enforcement or public safety purpose pursuant to a written request from the requesting agency. Written requests may be in electronic format."
