7	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
8	SECTION 1. G.S. 113-174.3(e), as enacted by subsection 14.8(o) of S.L.	
9	2013-360, reads as rewritten:	
10	"(e) Each individual who obtains a for-hire license shall may submit to the Division	
11	logbooks summarizing catch and effort statistical data to the Division. The Commission may	
12	adopt rules that determine the means and methods to satisfy the requirements of this	
13	subsection."	
14		ECTION 2. Section 14.8(ab) of S.L. 2013-360 reads as rewritten:
15	"SECTION 14.8.(ab) This G.S. 113-174(e), as enacted by subsection 14.8(o) of this	
16	section, becomes effective January 1, 2016. The remainder of this section becomes effective	
17	August 1, 2013."	
18	SECTION 3. Prior to implementation of the logbook requirement imposed by	
19	subsection 14.8(o) of S.L. 2013-360, the Division of Marine Fisheries shall conduct a 12-month	
20	implementation process to include seeking input from stakeholders with regard to the	
21	requirement and public workshops to provide education for persons subject to the requirement.	
22	The process shall also include the establishment of a stakeholder advisory group that includes,	
23	at a minimum, representatives from the organizations listed in G.S. 113-173.1(d), or the	
24 25	successors to those organizations. The Division shall review and provide a written response to	
25 26	any issues raised by the advisory group, and shall report to the Environmental Review	
26 27	Commission no later than January 15, 2016, regarding the implementation process required by
