A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO DIRECT THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO STUDY WAYS  
TO FUND IMPROVEMENTS TO INTERSTATE 95.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** Study. – The Department of Transportation shall study ways to fund improvements to Interstate 95 from the South Carolina to Virginia borders, including the feasibility of establishing tolls and managed lanes.

**SECTION 2.** Report. – The Department of Transportation shall report its findings and recommendations, including any legislative proposals, to the Joint Legislative Transportation Oversight Committee on or before February 1, 2016.

**SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
