1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT TO STUDY THE FINANCIAL COSTS TO THE STATE AND LOCAL SCHOOL 3 ADMINISTRATIVE UNITS TO RECEIVE FEDERAL EDUCATIONAL FUNDS AND 4 THE COST TO THE STATE AND LOCAL SCHOOL ADMINISTRATIVE UNITS OF 5 COMPLIANCE WITH FEDERAL MANDATES RELATED TO THE FUNDING. 6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 7 SECTION 1. By no later than January 1, 2016, the Department of Public Instruction shall study, report, and provide any supporting data to the Program Evaluation 8 Division on the cost of compliance with federal education funding mandates by local education 9 10 agencies.

11 SECTION 2. The Joint Legislative Program Evaluation Oversight Committee shall consider including in the 2015-2016 Work Plan for the Program Evaluation Division of the 12 General Assembly an evaluation of the cost of compliance with federal education funding 13 14 mandates for K-12 education and, if included in the Work Plan, report its findings and 15 recommendations to the General Assembly at a date to be determined by the Committee. 16

SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
