

North Carolina Statewide Reentry Advisory Council. 8 (a) The North Carolina Statewide Reentry Advisory Council is established within Department of Public Safety to provide the Governor, the General Assembly, the Depart of Public Safety, other state agencies that serve juvenile and adult offender populations, and public with accurate and comprehensive information about programs that serve juvenil adult offender populations upon their reentry into the community, the barriers faced by population upon reentry, best practices to meet the needs of that population upon reentry. 14 (b) The Advisory Council shall: 17 (1) Identify reentry and transition barriers and develop methods to address to among and between State, local, and nonprofit agencies.

1	The Council members set forth in subdivisions (1) through (5) of this subsection shall serve
2	two-year terms. Council members serving ex officio shall serve terms coinciding with their
3	respective offices.
4	The Secretary of Public Safety shall furnish such secretarial, clerical, and other services as
5	the Secretary deems necessary for the Advisory Council to perform its duties. Ex officio
6	members of the Advisory Council shall be compensated at the rate specified in G.S. 138-6.
7	Council members who are members of the General Assembly shall be compensated at the rate
8	specified in G.S. 120-31. Other Council members shall be compensated at the rate specified in
9	<u>G.S. 138-5.</u> "
10	SECTION 2. The North Carolina Statewide Reentry Advisory Council shall report
11	by February 1, 2016, to the Joint Legislative Oversight Committee on Justice and Public Safety
12	on its progress in responding to the tasks set forth in G.S. 143B-605(b), as enacted in this act.
13	SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
