7	SECTION 1.(a) G.S. 143-64.17L reads as rewritten:		
8	"(a) Authority. – Notwithstanding the provisions of this Part to the contrary, the Board

12	(1) The Board of Governors finds that the energy savings resulting from the		
13	implementation of the energy conservation measure shall, according to the		
14	energy savings analysis received pursuant to G.S. 143-64.17M(a), equal or		
15	exceed the total cost of implementing the measure. If the proposed		
16	implementation will be financed with debt, then the energy savings analysis		
17 18	must project sufficient energy savings to pay the debt service on any bonds		
19	to be issued. As used in this subdivision, the term "total cost' shall have the		
20	same meaning as it does in G.S. 143-64.17B(d).  (2) The energy conservation measure is for an existing building or utility
