5	SI	ECTION 1. G.S. 106-950(a) reads as rewritten:
6	"(a) Th	nis Article shall not apply and no air quality permit shall be required for any of the

8	(1)	to any Any fires started, or caused to be started, within 100 feet of an
9		occupied dwelling house if such fire shall be confined (i) within an enclosure
10		from which burning material may not escape or (ii) within a protected area
11		upon which a watch is being maintained and which is provided with
12		adequate fire protection equipment.
13	(2)	The burning of polyethylene agricultural plastic used in connection with
14		agricultural operations related to the growing, harvesting, or maintenance of
15		crops, when the plastic cannot be feasibly recycled, and the burning does not
16		create a public nuisance or result in a significant and adverse impact on
17		public health or the environment."
18	SI	ECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
