Short Title: Decriminalize Direct Entry Midwifery. (Public) Sponsors: Senators Rabin, Sanderson (Primary Sponsors); Cook, Hartsell, Krawiec, and McInnis. Rules and Operations of the Senate. Referred to: March 30, 2015 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT ALLOWING CERTIFIED PROFESSIONAL MIDWIVES TO PROVIDE CERTAIN MIDWIFERY SERVICES WITHOUT BEING SUBJECT TO CRIMINAL PENALTY. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. Chapter 90 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new Article to read: "Article 10B. "Practice of Midwifery by Certified Professional Midwives. "§ 90-178.10. Practice of midwifery by certified professional midwife. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, any person who is certified as a Certified Professional Midwife by the North American Registry of Midwives may provide prenatal, intrapartum, postpartum, and newborn care as defined in G.S. 90-178.2, in accordance with the Standards for Practice of the National Association of Certified Professional Midwives."

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2015.
